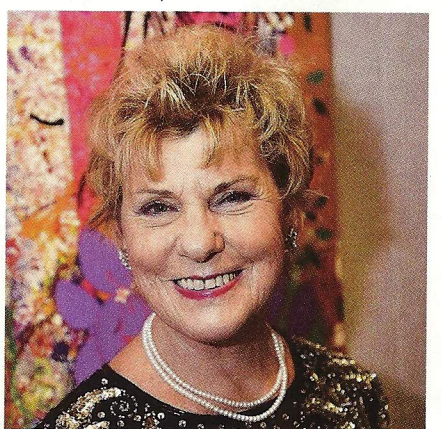

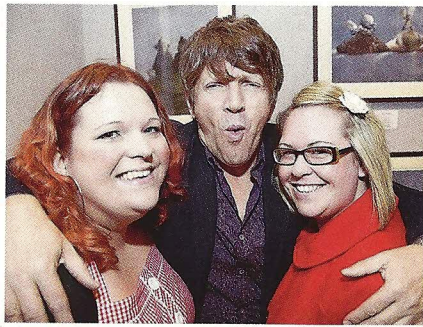
J'Adore Art!

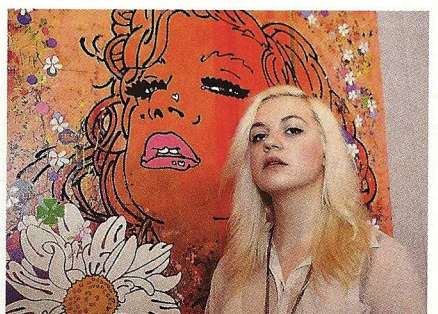
