

Contract for taxi CCTV

A COMPANY has won the contract to install CCTV cameras in taxis.

Taxis in Brighton and Hove will have to be fitted with CCTV cameras from this month in order to have their hackney licences renewed.

Keyhole Security, in Vale Road, Portslade, has been certified by Brighton and Hove Hackney Carriages to install the cameras.

All CCTV cameras installed in taxis in the city will have no audio.

Jason McCreaney, CEO at Keyhole Security, said: "The cost of installation is very low and we have provided many extras to make it reasonable for all taxi drivers in our city to have their taxis done as well as a free workshop to explain the process to them."
